5	Open Unit	Pinching injuries	Avoid placing fingers in any pinch point (where any moving parts of the unit meet)
6	Place trash into Unit	Lifting injuries	Get help if necessary when load is too heavy or bulky. Use correct lifting procedures.
			Never lift and twist.
			Observe good body positioning.
			Wear heavy nitrite coated puncture resistant gloves.
			Position the bin as close as possible to eliminate dropped or spilled bags.
