1	preparing to take garbage outside	<p>Elevated work platform or stairs Grated decks Rough terrain Slippery surfaces (water, ice, snow) Inadequate lighting</p> <p>Cold weather Inclement weather - lightning, high wind, snow, rain, sleet Heavy manual lifting/moving Uneven surfaces (curbs, gutters, drains, etc.) Blood borne pathogens</p>	<p>Look outside to determine current weather conditions in the area. Also scan the area for any wildlife that may be present. Follow site specific guidelines for any possible wildlife interactions.</p> <p>For cold weather exposure the minimum PPE required is: stocking type cap that covers the ears, safety glasses, arctic rated jacket, cold weather gloves and slip resistant footwear(traction devices may be required in some conditions).</p> <p>For warm weather the minimum PPE required is: safety glasses, nitrile gloves, slip resistant footwear</p>
2	Take trash to be disposed of to compactor	Lifting injuries	Clear path to compactor Use correct lifting procedures (See JSA: LIFTING)
3	Take trash to be disposed of to compactor	Slips, trips & falls injuries	Beware of obstacles, remove or compensate for them Use correct procedures on use of stairways

LN#	Task	Hazard	Control
4	Open Unit	Striking injuries	Be sure path is clear during opening motion
5	Open Unit	Pinching injuries	Avoid placing fingers in any pinch point (where any moving parts of the unit meet)
6	Place trash into Unit	Lifting injuries	<p>Get help if necessary when load is too heavy or bulky.</p> <p>Use correct lifting procedures.</p> <p>Never lift and twist.</p> <p>Observe good body positioning.</p> <p>Wear heavy nitrite coated puncture resistant gloves.</p> <p>Position the bin as close as possible to eliminate dropped or spilled bags.</p>
7	Activate Unit	Pinching / Crushing injuries	Stand away from unit when compactor is working
8	Repeat steps until disposing of trash is complete	Pinching / Crushing injuries	Stand away from unit when compactor is working
9	Preparing the compactor for use,	Pinch points, electrical, hydraulic	Train all baler operators – Thoroughly
