| 3 | Preparing for Use | Trips and Falls | Clear work area of debris and trip hazards | |

| 8 | Procedure for malfunctioning or broken equipment | Bodily Injury | Obtain Accident Prevention Tagmark equipment "Do Not Use" – specify problem or hazard Whenever possible isolate power source so equipment cannot be used. (Lock OutTag Out) Notify shop and/or take equipment to shop | |
| 9 | Using Pressure Washer | Hand Injury | Wear appropriate gloves | |
| 10 | Using Pressure Washer | Electric Shock | Follow manufacturer's instructions, do not spray electrical equipment, energized electrical components, and stay an approved distance from all power lines Ensure power is locked out by campus electricians if potential to contact energized electrical equipment | |
