1	Cleaning Compactor Area (including use of shop vacuum)	Muscle Strain	<p>Use proper ergonomics;</p> <p>Bend at the knees.</p> <p>Do not ever reach.</p> <p>Use short movements, avoid twisting and bending.</p> <p>Use two man lift if needed to empty shop vacuum or do not load to a weight of more than one person can safely lift.</p>
2	Cleaning Compactor Area (including use of shop vacuum)	Scrapes /Abrasions/ Impact Injuries from Hand Tools	<p>Wear protective clothing such as gloves, pants and/or coveralls.</p> <p>Wear protective footwear (steel or composite toe).</p>
3	Cleaning Compactor Area (including use of shop vacuum)	Electrical Hazards	<p>Check cord and plug of shop vacuum before use.</p> <p>Use grounded extension cords (as needed).</p>
4	Preparing to Clean Compactor Area	Vehicle Hazards	<p>Mark area with safety cones, barricades, or flagging tape to warn of workers in area.</p>
