1 Prepare Work Area	Trips and Falls	<ul> <li>Clear area within work zone; Remove trip hazards and/ or mark clearly hazards with cones, etc.</li> </ul>
2 After Operations or during periods when area is not occupied by workers.	Bodily Injury to Workers and Others.	<ul> <li>Operator should always leave equipment in down position</li> <li>Operator should ensure equipment is secured/locked out so cannot be used by unauthorized personnel</li> <li>Workers should secure job site with barricades, cones and signs to warn others to keep out of work site</li> </ul>
3 Prepare Work Area	Injuries to Operator, Co-workers, and By-standers	<ul> <li>Warn people in work area; utilize barricades, cones, and caution tape to keep bystanders a safe distance away; position lift away from traffic, building overhangs, and power lines; level truck base and block wheels</li> <li>Post employee as "look out" as needed in heavy traffic areas (vehicles and pedestrians)</li> </ul>
4 During Operations	Bodily Injury to Workers	<ul> <li>Wear reflective safety vest, hard hat and safety glasses</li> <li>A pre-job discussion should occur to ensure both the equipment operator and assisting workers understand the scope of the project</li> <li>Operator should keep watch for</li> </ul>
